## What is Project Youth, Inc?

A youth service that offers a great range of programs and services with the aim of creating opportunities for young people to determine their own future.

We are a public benevolent Institution, with DGR and ITEC status and hold a NSW Charity Number.

Donations to the Association of \$2 or more are tax deductible.

Project Youth receives all kinds of donations—from pool tables, to bed sheets; from dishes to toys and games; from clothes to furniture, and just about everything in between. We run 3 youth centres, 4 share houses, 1 short term youth refuge, 2 emergency food relief services (at Menai and Miranda, where young people, who are homeless or doing it tough can access dry and tinned food, as well as toiletries), 6 leasehold properties and a block of 8 units.

We're always on the look out for clean, quality home furnishings and equipment to either pass on to homeless young people setting up home for the first time or to use in one of the Centres or share houses.

Cash donations are also very welcome and mean that we can offer a greater range of support services to young people as well as provide things that they would not normally be able to afford.
